We would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone once again for their kindness and generosity. Your contributions will make a meaningful difference to families in need this Christmas.





As a school we marked UK Parliament Week an annual event dedicated to raising awareness about the UK Parliament, its functions, and ways for people to get involved.

As part of the celebrations, we had the privilege of welcoming our Member of Parliament for Dwyfor Meirionnydd, Liz Saville Roberts, to our school. Liz met with the school council, prefects, and other students interested in government and politics for an engaging and insightful afternoon.

The session began with Liz providing a detailed overview of her role as an MP, offering students a glimpse into her week-to-week responsibilities and how government operates. Following this, she opened the floor to our pupils, who had prepared questions and topics through discussions with their form classes.

The topics raised by our students were wide-ranging and heartfelt, reflecting genuine concerns about life in our community. Issues discussed included:

Transport challenges
Healthcare services
Limited recreational opportunities for young people
Inheritance tax
The closure of Coed y Brenin
Struggles faced by local businesses



Pryderon am gyffuriau, trosed, ac ansicrwydd yn yr ardal

Cododd thema gyffredin: roedd llawer o bobl ifanc yn mynigi teimlad o gael eu hanwybyddu, yn enwedig yn Nhywyn ac ardal ehangach de Gwynedd.

Roedd yr angerdd a'r didwylledd a ddangoswyd gan ein disgylion yn ddwys ac yn agoriad llygad i bawb. Roedd yr staff yn hynod falch o'u hyder a'u gonest wrth iddynt rannu eu profiadau a'u safbwytiau. Roedd eu brwdfrydedd mor gryf nes y byddent wedi parhau i ofyn cwestiynau hyd nes yn hwyr y nos, pe bai amser yn caniatâu!

'Daeth Liz Saville-Roberts i ein ysgol yn ddiweddar. Daeth y swyddogion, y cyngor ysgol ac pawb arall sydd eisiau dod. Siaradodd Liz am ei bywyd hi fel gwleidydd. Wedyn gyfonodd pawb ac fi ein cwestiynau i hi. Y pwnciau mwyaf poblogaidd oedd amdan teithio, cyfeuon yn yr ardal ac amdan y heddlu ac y gwasanaeth iechyd. Atebodd Liz Saville-Roberts ein cwestiynau yn fanwl, ac roddodd datrysion i'r problemau nathon ni meddwl amdan. Roedd hi yn gofalu am yr ardal ac roedd o yn diddorol iawn i siarad ac gwrando arna hi'-Ava Hussein, Blwyddyn 9.'

Daeth y sesiwn i ben gyda chwestiwn ysgogol gan grŵp o fyfyrwyr a ofynnodd i Liz a oedd mynd i mewn i wleidyddiaeth fel gyrrfa yn werth chweil. Mynegodd un myfyriwr, yn arbennig, ddiidordeb mawr yn y maes, gan sbarduno trafodaeth ystyrlon am bwysigrwydd cymryd rhan wleidyddol.

Gan edrych ymlaen, bydd y cyngor ysgol yn adrodd yn ôl i'w dosbarthiadau, ac gyda'i gilydd byddant yn anelu at weithio i wneud gwahaniaeth cadarnhaol i bobl ifanc sy'n byw yn Nhywyn a'r ardaloedd cyfagos.

Concerns around drugs, crime, and safety in the area
A common theme emerged: many young people expressed feeling unheard and overlooked, particularly in Tywyn and the wider South Gwynedd area.

The passion and sincerity with which our students spoke were both overwhelming and eye-opening. Staff were incredibly proud to witness their confidence and honesty as they shared their experiences and perspectives. Such was their enthusiasm that many would have continued asking questions well into the evening if time had allowed!

'Liz Saville-Roberts recently visited our school. Prefects, school council and anyone who wanted to join came along. Liz told us about her day to day life as a politician, about her trips into London and her time at her constituency. We then had an opportunity to ask her questions. The main topics we discussed were to do with travel, opportunities in the local area and emergency services such as the police and the health service. Liz Saville-Roberts answered all our questions in detail giving us next steps and solutions to any issues that were raised. She was very informative and cared a lot about our local area. It was very interesting to meet and talk with her'-Ava Hussein, Year 9.'

The session concluded with a thought-provoking question from a group of students who asked Liz whether pursuing a career in politics was worthwhile. particular, expressed a strong interest in the field, sparking a meaningful discussion about the importance of political engagement.

Looking ahead, the school council will now report back to their classes, and together they aim to work towards making a positive impact for young people living in Tywyn and its surrounding areas.

Da iawn i'r merched – rydym yn falch iawn ohonoch!





he trip was not just about physical endurance; it was about resilience, teamwork, and the pure joy of being immersed in nature.









Effaith ysmogu ar y corff a pheryglon e-sigaréts. Strategaethau i wrthsefyll pwysau cyfoedion ac wneud penderfyniadau gwybodus.

Ers cwblhau eu hyfforddiant, mae'r disgyblion hyn wedi bod yn rhannu'r neges Smoke-Free yn weithredol, gan addysgu eu cyd-ddisgyblion a'u ffrindiau.

Year 8– Just B Smoke Free

Earlier this year, a group of influential Year 8 students were selected to lead the Just B Smoke-Free initiative. - They completed a two-day training course at Neuadd Pendre, delivered by Smoking Prevention Trainers from Public Health Wales.

Weekly training sessions are continuing in school. What they've learned: The 4,000+ chemicals found in cigarettes (including rat poison and paint stripper!) through a 'chemical soup' activity. The impact of smoking on the body and the risks of e-cigarettes. Strategies to resist peer pressure and make informed choices.


Since their training, these students have been actively spreading the Smoke-Free message, sharing their knowledge with classmates and peers.
