Assisting with Open Evenings, school events, and community activities,

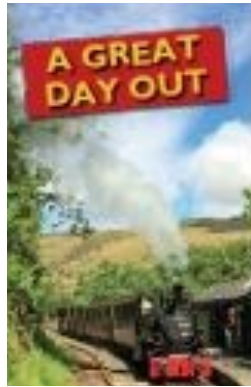
representing Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn and providing a friendly face for visitors and prospective students.

Cymerodd y cadetiaid ran mewn cwrs rhwystrau a gyflwynodd heriau a brofodd eu stamina a'u hyblygrwydd, dringo creigiau, ogofa, a hyd yn oed ymarfer tân gwag, cysgu allan yn y gwyllt, saethu peli paent, ac yn olaf symud ymlaen i saethu bwledi go iawn, gyda Noah a'i ffrind Harry yn cael un o'r canlyniadau gorau yn eu platŵn, gyda dim ond 15mm rhwng y bwledi. Wedi iddo ennill ei Wobr Un Seren, mae Noah yn edrych ymlaen at weithio'n galed tuag at ei Ddwy Seren.

"Roedd yr wythnos yn y gweryll yn hwyl fawr, cawsom gyfle i saethu reifflau ac roeddem hyd yn oed yn gallu saethu bwledi go iawn o L85A3. Ar un adeg yn y gweryll, bu'n rhaid i ni aros y tu allan dros nos (crefft maes) a bu'n rhaid i ni fynd ar gerdded platŵn cyfan lle roedd yn rhaid i ni 'ymosod' ar ganolfan ac ennill gwybodaeth, ond ni lwyddodd hynny oherwydd nad oeddem hyd yn oed wedi cyrraedd y man cywir, felly bu'n rhaid i ni ymsuddo'n ôl i'r gweryll yn grymu yr holl ffordd yn ôl, gan orfod cropian ar un adeg! Roedd y profiad o gysgu yn wahanol, nid y mwyaf cyfforddus.

Ar y diwrnod cyn y diwrnod olaf aeth rhai ohonom i ogofa ac nid oedd mor hwyl ag y mae'n swnio. Cadet Noah Cooper part of Tywyn detachment attended Clwyd and Gwynedd ACF summer camp at Altcar Training camp on 3/8/24 until 9/8/24.

The cadets took part in obstacle courses which presented challenges that tested endurance and agility, rock climbing, caving and even a blank firing exercise, sleeping out in the wild, shooting paintballs and finally moving onto shooting live rounds, Noah and friend Harry getting one of the best results out of their platoon, 15mm distance between the bullets. Now awarded his one star award Noah looks forward to working hard towards his two stars.

"The week at camp was really fun, we got to shoot rifles and even got to fire live rounds out of a L85A3. At one point of the camp we had to stay outside at night (field craft) we had to go on a whole platoon walk where we had to 'infiltrate' a base and get intel, however that didn't work out due to the fact we hadn't even gone to the right area so we had to crouch all the way back to camp even crawling at one point! Sleeping was an

experience, not the comfiest.

On the day before the final day some of us went caving and it wasn't as fun as it sounds. The water was coming in hard and it had been raining recently so it was a huge gush of water wherever you went and at the near end part it was horrible, the water was so high up and we had to quite literally get on our buckle belts and crawl through the ice cold water.

On the last day I got my 1 star training badge meaning I had passed my 1 star and was now going to start my 2 star training which hopefully I can pass that. Overall camp was really fun and I would definitely go next year."

Llongyfarchiadau i baw a gymerodd ran, camp wych!

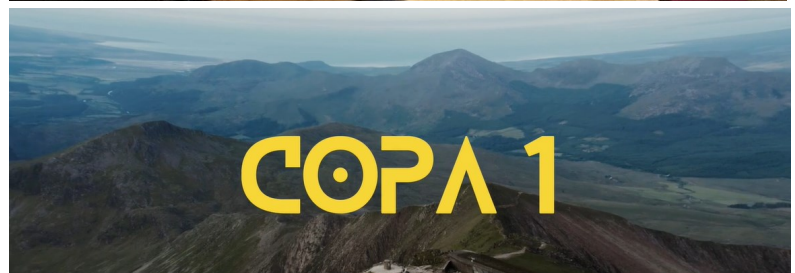
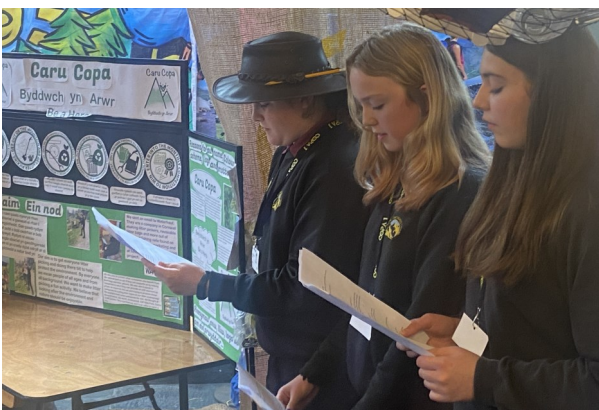
COPA1 Environmental Summit Competition-Snowdon

Two teams from Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn participated in a conference focused on reducing plastic waste on Snowdon. This competition was organized by the Snowdonia National Park.

Out of 79 teams that applied, only 9 teams were selected to present their ideas at the conference. The teams pitched their solutions to a panel of judges, including their local Member of Parliament, Liz Saville Roberts.

After the presentations, the students had the chance to travel to the summit of Snowdon by small train. The event concluded with an awards ceremony, where Sylvie, Martha, and Deri's team won first place. They were awarded £1,500 to further develop their environmental initiatives.

STEM– Trip i Llanbedr/Trip to Llanbedr 09/10/24

Ar ddydd Mercher, cychwynnodd disgyblion Blwyddyn 8 ar antur gyffrous ac addysgol i Snowdonia Aerospace yn Llanbedr.

Roedd y daith yn llawn hwyl, dysgu a gweithgareddau ymarferol, gyda phopeth wedi'i ganolbwyntio ar fyd cyffrous STEMGwyddoniaeth, Technoleg, Peirianneg, a Mathemateg). O'r eiliad y cyrhaeddodd nhw, cafodd y myfyrwyr eu trochi mewn diwrnod llawn profiadau ymarferol.

Un o uchafbwyntiau'r diwrnod oedd y gweithdy adeiladu rocedi, lle cafodd y disgyblion eu tasgu i ddylunio, cydosod, a phrofi eu rocedi eu hun. O dan arweiniad arbenigwyr, dysgodd y myfyrwyr egwyddorion awyredyddiaeth, gyriant, a dylunio.

Roedd rhan hynod arall o'r diwrnod yn brofiad y tu mewn i blanedariwm chwyddadwy enfawr. Wrth i'r disgyblion gamu i mewn i'r gromen, roedd fel pe baent wedi'u cludo i fyd hollol wahanol. Aethon nhw ar daith rithwir trwy system solar. Rhoddodd y cyflwyniad trochi olygfeydd iddyn nhw o blanedau pell, lleuadau a sêr, tra'n dysgu ffeithiau hynod ddiddorol am y bydysawd.

The trip was packed with fun, learning, and hands-on activities, all centered around the exciting world of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics). From the moment they arrived, the students were immersed in a day full of curiosity-driven and practical experiences.

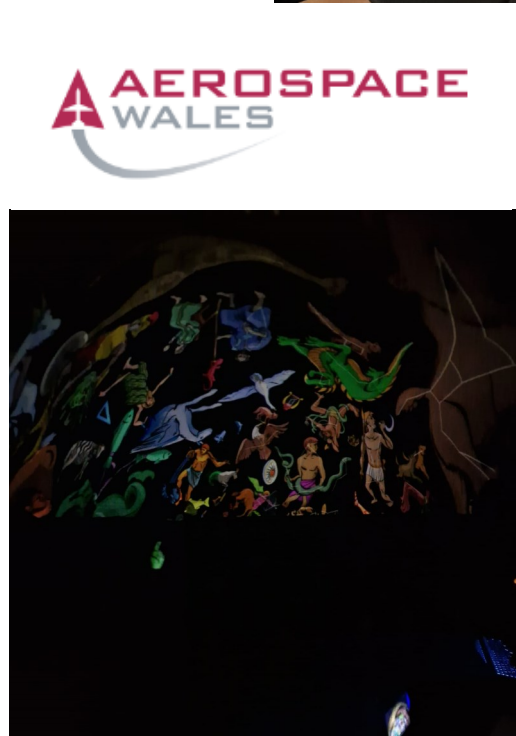
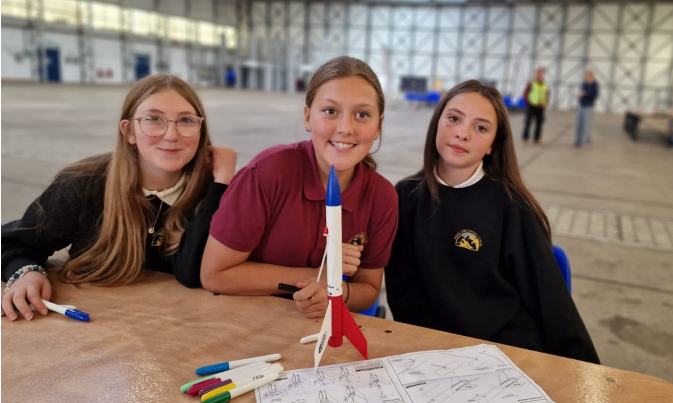
One of the highlights of the day was the rocket-building workshop, where the pupils were tasked with designing, assembling, and testing their very own rockets. Under the guidance of experts, the students learned the principles of aerodynamics, propulsion, and design.

Another captivating part of the day was an experience inside a massive, inflatable planetarium. As the students entered the dome, they were transported to a completely different world. They embarked on a virtual journey through the solar system. The immersive presentation allowed them to witness views of distant planets, moons, and stars, all while learning fascinating facts about the universe.

But the excitement didn't stop there! As the day drew to a close, there was one final, thrilling event that had everyone on the edge of their seats. In a dramatic and entertaining science demonstration, Mrs. Spencer volunteered for an unusual experiment. To the students' amazement she was chosen to have her hands set on fire in a controlled and safe experiment. The demonstration, which showcased the science of combustion safety, had everyone wide-eyed with excitement as the flames danced harmlessly on her hands before being safely extinguished.

The trip to Snowdonia Aerospace was not only a day of fun but also an opportunity for the students to engage deeply with STEM subjects, sparking curiosity and perhaps inspiring future engineers, scientists, and astronauts among them.

It was a day that truly brought learning to life in most exciting and hands-on way imaginable!
